Nasruddin earned his living selling eggs. Someone came to his shop one day and said, "Have a guess what I am holding in my hand.



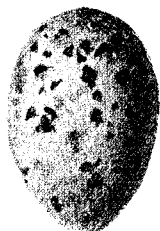
"Give me a clue," said Nasruddin.

Inside it is yellow and white. It is liquid before it is cooked, becomes thick when heated. It was, moreover, laid by a hen."

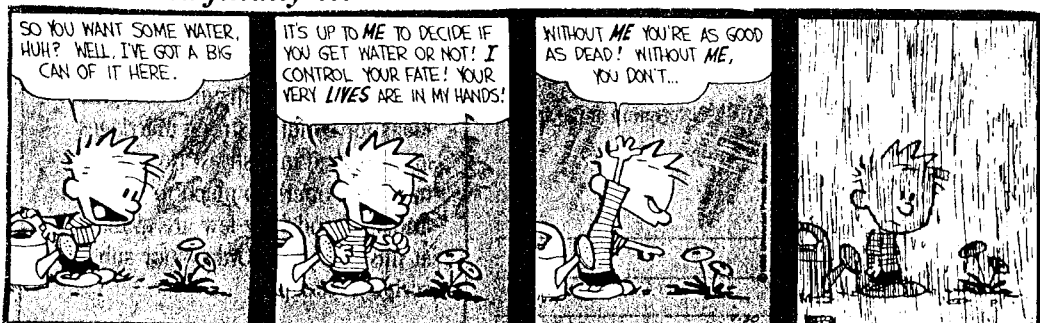
"Aha! I know!" Said Nasruddin. "It is some sort of cake?"
