Regulation 16 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012**

Sedlescombe Parish Council, as the qualifying body, has prepared a Neighbourhood Plan for its parish. The Plan proposes a vision for the parish and a number of planning policies to be used in the determination of planning applications locally.

Copies of the Sedlescombe Neighbourhood Plan and supporting documents will be available for public inspection for seven weeks commencing on the **19th August 2014** and ending on the **7th October 2014**.

All representations must be received by the Council **no later than 4.30pm on 7th October 2014**. Any submissions received after this deadline cannot be considered.

Please note that all representations will be publicly available and will be forwarded for consideration by the person appointed to carry out an examination of the Plan.

Anyone making a representation may request to be notified of the Council's decision to 'make' the Sedlescombe Neighbourhood Plan by ticking the relevant box on the representation form.
